## The vision of Heavenly Days

Heavenly Days in Silkeborg is part of Danish Church Days. The vision behind Danish Church Days is to create a church people's meeting for interchurch events like Heavenly Days.

Danish Church Days aims to

- create space and community for people who inquire about Christian faith
- gather Christians and strengthen them in their faith
- encourage the church to take responsibility
- enable witness and engagement in society
- contribute to fellowship with Christians from around the world.

With this goal in mind Heavenly Days and other open forums are held, where people with widely different vocations, church traditions and confessions, theology and forms of expression come together across generations, cultures, and ethnicities, and where thoughts and opinions meet and are exchanged. Here, they celebrate worship together, seek a deeper understanding of faith, become aware of their responsibilities in and for society both near and far, and commit to the church's unity and ecumenical breadth locally and globally. Here, renewal of the church is encouraged, and renewal initiatives are promoted.

## Heavenly Days takes place in Silkeborg

Heavenly Days in Silkeborg is centred on the stretch from Silkeborg Church along the pedestrian street to the RC Church of Our Lady and on to Lunden. The area around Skoletorvet and Bindslev Plads with the library, schools, the senior high school, and the community centre is host to the 'Marketplace of Opportunities', various activities, talks, and debates. Concerts take place at various venues, such as Kedelhuset. Silkeborg Station is close by as a hub for travellers by train, bus, or car.
